The one-hour concert takes place in the auditorium, and last year's performances represented Zimbabwean, Scottish, Indian, Taíno, Bulgarian, Israeli, Tibetan, Korean, Javanese, and Global Pop (Zumba) traditions. Note that because space is limited at International Night, submissions for student performances and hosting a cultural table will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
